Brecksville Road (SR21) Resurfacing Project

Project Update October 24, 2025

WORK PERFORMED THE LAST TWO MONTHS:

- Center Lanes of Stage 1 - Phase 2 (Sprague Rd - St. Basil's)
 - Milled 3 inches of asphalt from the roadway surface.
 - Performed full and partial-depth pavement repairs.
 - Paved the intermediate course of asphalt.
 - Adjusted all castings within the pavement.
 - Completing an emergency storm sewer repair in the northbound center lane.
 - Replaced approximately 3,500 linear feet of curb and median.
 - Shifted traffic back to Phase 1 conditions, with vehicles now traveling on the center lanes while curb lanes remain closed.
 - Reviewed and replaced curb ramps as needed to ensure ADA compliance.



WORK PLANNED FOR NEXT MONTH:

- Weather permitting, Ronyak will complete the final surface course paving during the week of October 27–29:
 - Monday (10/27): Paving curb lanes
 - Tuesday (10/28): Paving center lanes and intersections
 - Wednesday (10/29): Completing remaining intersections and paving commercial and residential drive aprons.
- Additional work will include
 - Cut in loop detectors at SR21 and Sprague Rd.
 - Apply permanent pavement marking
- Due to the late season, once paving and striping are complete, Ronyak will demobilize the project for the winter. Work will resume on July 1, 2026, with resurfacing of Stage 2 (St. Basil's to Downtown Brecksville). Additional updates and notices will be shared in spring 2026 as construction restarts.



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SPECIAL PROJECT NOTES:

- When paving operations are in front of your driveway, access will be temporarily restricted for approximately 30 minutes while asphalt is placed, graded, and compacted. Please follow instructions from paving personnel for safe crossing.
- Use extra caution when traveling through the work zone—for your safety and for the safety of the construction crew.
- We sincerely appreciate your continued patience and cooperation as we work to improve Brecksville Road for all who live, work, and travel in the community.
